

Article 0807-3A: DRINKING IN A PUBLIC PLACE

Section I:

- A. No person shall consume, open a container of or carry an open container of malt beverage, wine, or intoxicating liquor in a "PUBLIC AREA" within the Township or in any vehicle parked therein. "PUBLIC AREA" is defined for the purpose of this ordinance as:
 - 1. Public highways, roads, streets, or parking lots open to the public, except as authorized below.
 - 2. Village or Town property including property designated for school and recreational use, except as authorized below.

Section II:

The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to:

- A. An area or event at which consumption of alcoholic beverages is authorized by the Town Liquor Control Board, or;
- B. Any place or event licensed for on-premise sale of alcoholic beverages.

Section III

- A. Any person, firm, co-partnership, or corporation violating this article shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not more than Five Hundred dollars (\$500) or imprisoned not more than sixty (60) days or both.
