

Article 0807-5: EXHIBITION PERMITS

Selectmen may permit the exhibition in the Town of Morristown of any Show, Carnival, Menageries, Wild West Show and Itinerant Shows, by payment of the owners or operators, thereof, for the use of the Town, of not more than one hundred (100) dollars or less than ten (10) dollars for each day for which exhibitions are given in such Town.

PAYMENT shall be made seven (7) days in advance of when said show is to open. Upon payment of permit fees, the owners or operators may operate as outlined herein:

"You are further notified that your operations will be subject to the revocation of your permit should the Board of Selectmen be satisfied that your exhibition disturbs the public peace."

Failure to pay the fee will constitute operating without a license and the provisions of Title 31, VSA §404 may apply.
