

Article 0807-5.1 ITINERANT VENDORS, PEDDLERS, FOOD SALES

Authority: 24 V.S.A § 2291, (9), (15)

Section I:

No person, firm or corporation shall operate a lunch wagon, ice cream truck, mobile or temporary stand on public property for the purpose of a food or craft sale until a license has been obtained from the Morristown Selectboard. Prescribed license fee and certificate of insurance with a minimum coverage amount of \$1,000,000 shall be paid and presented to the Town Administration Office prior to issuance of a license.

- A. No license shall be so issued without the approval in writing of the Selectboard.
- B. Licenses shall be valid from April 1- November 15. Written applications for license shall be filed with the Town Administration on or before March 1 each year by persons then engaged in such business and the required fee shall be deposited with the application along with a copy of their certificate of insurance and a copy of their State Health Permit. Written application by persons beginning such business after April 1 shall be made at least 30 (30) days in advance of business start date.
- C. Such License is not transferable.
- D. For each License period or fractional part thereof, the license fee for a lunch wagon, ice cream truck, mobile or temporary stand shall be 75.00 (\$75.00).
- E. Location of Service(s) shall be indicated on License. As well as vehicle description and Plate #.
- F. Upon approval of the application, a license certificate signed by the authorized representative of the Morristown Selectboard, shall be issued to the licensee, who at all times shall keep said certificate posted in a conspicuous place in the place of business and upon notice of suspension or revocation of license, shall surrender forthwith such license certificate to the Selectboard.
- G. The Morristown Selectboard reserves the right to revoke said license after a warned public meeting.
- H. The Town of Morristown Selectboard shall have the authority to limit the number of permits under this ordinance if the Selectboard deems that a nuisance is being created by said vendors.
- I. All vendors, peddlers and other persons covered by this ordinance shall only be allowed to do business in designated areas. The operation on school grounds is regulated by Lamoille South School District.

Exemptions:

Exempted from this ordinance are those selling fruits, vegetables or other farm produce and those utilizing private property with a valid zoning permit for operations described in Section 1 of this ordinance.

Violation: Penalty

Every person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance may be punished by a fine of not less than \$25.00, no more than \$50.00 per violation.
